Report of the Special General Meeting held on 13.06.2025

The first special general meeting of the Siyambalanduwa Constituency was held on 13.06.2025 at 9.30 a.m. with the participation of 21 members of the Siyambalanduwa Constituency Council, who were elected on 06 May 2025. Accordingly, the National Assembly conducted religious ceremonies in accordance with the tradition to commence the preliminary proceedings of the special general meeting of the Constituency Council. First, the Honorable Speaker welcomed all the members, the media and the staff who had arrived and the proceedings of the House were concluded in accordance with the law. Thereafter, the Speaker invited the Secretary of the House to introduce the legal situation regarding the seating of the House and the conduct of legal proceedings. Accordingly, the Secretary of the House began his speech by congratulating the Honorable Speaker and the members of the House. Honorable Speaker, the inaugural session of the Seventh House begins. The appointment of these officers was published in the Gazette No. 2438/87 dated 31st May 2025 issued by the Election Commission, while the appointment of the Hon. Speaker and the Vice-Chairman was published in the Gazette No. 2438/92 dated 31st May 2025 issued by the Election Commission. The Hon. Speaker will take the chair today, and the Hon. Speaker, in the absence of the Speaker, will be able to seat members according to their special status. More members are also expected to attend. The Speaker of the House, who is still sitting at the discretion of the House, shall have full responsibility and all powers of the House, as long as they are published in the Gazette. All matters shall be conducted at his discretion and direction. The Speaker of the House declared that the certification of all vouchers in accordance with the Special Council Finance and Revenue Act, 1988 (Act 99) shall be delegated to the Speaker of the House, and the approval of the payment of vouchers shall be delegated to the Council. Accordingly, the House unanimously resolved that it is appropriate to reserve these powers equally to the Speaker of the House and the Council Secretary.

After the Hon. Chairman explained the purpose of the Special Council meeting, the dates for the Special Council General Meetings for the next 06 months were decided. The proposal made by the Hon. Chairman P.S. Asanka Idunil that it would be appropriate to hold the meeting on the last Friday of every month at 9.00 a.m. was seconded by Hon. Member S.R.M.

The Hon. Amaravathi also decided that it would be appropriate to hold the last Friday of every month, even if it falls on a public holiday. The Hon. Council sought the opinion of the Council in this regard. Accordingly, since there was no objection to the selection of this day, that date was decided upon by unanimous consent of all the Council members. Thereafter, the members of the respective committees shall be elected in accordance with Section 12(2) of Act No. 15 of 1987. Further, the Committees shall

The Hon. Chairman of the Council proposed to the Council that the powers conferred by Section 216 of the Local Council Act No. 15 of 1987 be vested in the officers as specified in the said Act. The Hon. Chairman of the Council Asanka Indunil moved the said motion. It was discussed in the Council and since there were no objections, the Council unanimously decided that it would be appropriate to implement those powers with effect from 13.06.2025.
